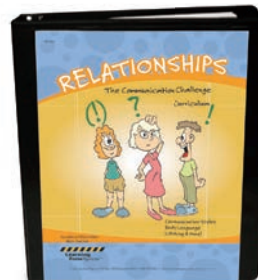
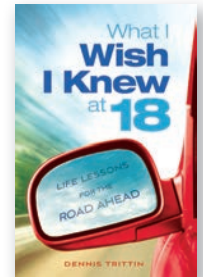
What's Next?
