Students will...

- Learn a new glazing technique
- Apply color theory knowledge

Directions

Step 1

Draw simple line drawings for tile designs on paper the size of the tiles. In this case, the tiles are 6" x 6".



Step 2

Transfer the drawing to the tile by layering a sheet of transfer paper between the drawing and the tile.



Step 3

Draw over the design lines with pencil.



Step 4

Draw over the lines with the raised accent glaze and fire the tile in the kiln.



Step 5

After the tile has been fired, continue to add the first layer of color with glazes and fire for a second time.



Step 6

Add more details to the tile with the SuperWriter pens and fire a third time.

Step 7

The tiles can be framed or mounted in a mural.
